## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The provider maintains a valid paediatric first-aid qualification. She is aware of how this helps her understand how to respond to minor accidents and injuries appropriately.
- The provider understands her role in safeguarding and protecting children from harm. She understands the importance of the dealing with any concerns, including how to report these to the appropriate agencies.
- The provider recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals involved in the care of the children.
- The provider explains how she evaluates her work, seeks ways to improve her skills and ensures her childcare knowledge is up to date.
- The provider understands how to positively manage children's behaviour, and how to encourage children to respect each other and others.
- The provider understands how to plan and use resources to excite children and help them to make good developmental progress.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
